The PortoBay Hotel Teatro is a 4-star hotel in Porto belonging to the PortoBay Group. After being fully refurbished in the first half of 2021, it is now reopening its doors with a fresher, brighter and fully rejuvenated image. It is located in the theater district, right in the historical center of the city, in Rua Sá da Bandeira. It is just a few steps from the city's main attractions including São Bento Station, Clérigos Tower, Porto Cathedral, Avenida dos Aliados, Lello Bookshop, Bolhão Market and the well-known Cais da Ribeira, the Douro riverfront. At the entrance, in the main common area of the hotel is the reception and lounge where subtle décor highlights Nordic elements, natural fabrics and light wood paneling. Next to the entrance, but with its own access, the Il Basilico restaurant offers Italian comfort food flavors in the bruschettas, tortelloni, pizzas and risottos that find their way to the tables. The Il Basilico bar serves some dishes from the menu when the restaurant is closed. This area can be completely open to the street giving the feeling of a porch or indoor terrace.

Find more about the tradition of Port wine and Portuguese gastronomy in this 3h guided visit into the heart of the Porto city! Meet your guide and join us to experience the city's flavours: the wine, the gastronomy, and the canned sardines. First, you will have the opportunity to meet one of the most emblematic markets of Oporto: The Bolhão Market, aimed for fresh products, mainly food. With four main entrances, its construction is characterized by its monumentality, typical of neoclassical architecture. Lose yourself in the aromas, colours, and sound so typical of this city market.

A little further up, we present the renowned Café Majestic, revivalist style of French inspiration, an icon in the city. More than a cafe, Majestic tells the story of Porto in the twentieth century and it was home for political gatherings and debate of ideas. This was the "Belle Epoque" Porto of writers and artists.

Arriving downtown, it's time to sample, the famous Portuguese canned sardines. Prepare yourself to taste the best Portuguese sardines available in a quaint location in Porto.

Further down, taste some unique Portuguese jams, also in a commented tasting. Try a unique flavor experience of fruit jams in tubes.

Heading towards the other shore, Vila Nova de Gaia, the world-famous port wine is produced exclusively from grapes from the region adjacent to the Douro and, even though it is produced with Douro grapes and stored in the cellars in Vila Nova de Gaia, it ended up being known as "Port Wine", so you are in just the right place to drink this nectar.

Here you will have the opportunity to taste a few Ports on a commented proof in a place and brand of excellency.

After the 3-hour tour walking around Porto, we end the tour in a beautiful, typical and local tavern with authentic flavours for lunch, where you can enjoy this delicious meal in your own privacy! Here you will taste the Portuguese delicacies with a meal of cheeses and smoked meat selection, accompanied by the best house wine. Bon Appetit!

## Lisbon: Private Lisbon Roots, Food & Cultural Walking Tour (3.5 hours) - DT

This walk takes you off the beaten track to get a unique glimpse into the fascinating history of ancient Lisbon. A walk through two very ancient neighborhoods: Mouraria and Downtown. Along the stroll, our guests will experience the very real and local vibe at the same time they taste what we local taste and enjoy every day. We take them from the historical Lisbon of the 12th century till the current times. In a stroll by the off beaten path, they will find out why Mouraria is such a unique place - the birthplace of the Fado music and the most multicultural neighbourhood in Lisbon. 6 stops are included for the guests to be introduced to very local places and to taste the icons and staples of Portuguese food culture and its influences.

- Distance: 1,2 miles/2km.

- Duration: 3,5 hours.

- Included: Guided visit + 10 tastings samples

- Physical level: medium - the itinerary involves a certain amount of uphill walking on cobblestones and climbing down steps, typical from old Lisbon streets.

- What to bring: appetite, good mood, a bottle of water, comfortable clothes and shoes adapted to the weather.

- Ideal for: Lisbon first-time visitors and history lovers.

- Meeting point with guide: São Domingos church in Largo São Domingos, beside the Star of David (near Rossio square), Lisbon downtown.

### More Important Information

**ADDITIONAL TAX INFORMATION:** Various city councils in Europe have introduced a new accommodation/city tax to generate additional revenue for the improvement of services and infrastructure offered to the tourist. New cities are constantly adopting these measures and the amount of the tax varies from country to country and city to city.

The amount of the tax is based on the cost and number of stars of the hotel (from 3 Euros per person per day for a 3\* hotel to possibly 10 Euros per person per day for a 5\* property.)

Although our packages include the European VAT (Value Added Tax), this accommodation tax is to be paid by the GUEST directly to the hotel before the end of the stay and cannot be prepaid. It is then remitted directly to the city council by the hotels.

- If you are having difficulty locating the driver, then please call the number(s) noted on the itinerary for the local Supplier.
